

## OUT OF BOUNDS

1. Open Picture – Duplicate the layer
2. Click on the Mask Tool (found at the bottom of the tool pallet)
3. With the paint tool, paint a mask around the item or subject that will look like it Jumps out of the photo.
  - Once the background around item is painted, click on the Mask Tool to find item selected with “Marching Ants.”
4. Copy the item by clicking Command “C”
5. Make a NEW blank layer and paste the item Command “V”
6. Click back on the background layer and click the Rectangular Marque Tool
7. Click and drag a rectangle box. Select the area that you want you subject to be jumping out of. Copy the selection Command “C”. Make a NEW blank layer box and hit Command “V” to paste on this new layer. Drag this layer beneath the other new blank layer 1 but above the other layers.
8. Click the “FX” which is the Add a Layer Style. Click on the STROKE and change the color to white and make the stroke border to look the sample below (like a bordered picture). Now click on the DROP SHADOW and make a nice feathered drop shadow and drag the distance with the ANGLE straight up which is 90 degrees.
9. Now select both the new layers by holding down command or shift and then Right Click and select Merge Layers or select the top window menu and click and hold Layer and open up the window and go down to Merge Layers.
10. Now click the Free Transform, which is Command “T” and click on the Warp Tool found at the top of the Menu. Warp the photo to look like the sample or get creative and make it look like a floating piece of paper.
11. To make the background with a gradient, make another NEW blank layer and drag it under the other new layers but above the older background layers. Click the tool GRADIENT found under the Paint Bucket. Find a nice accent gradient on the menu bar at the top. Click and drag on the project to make a nice gradient.
12. The last step is to flatten the Layers and save your project!
