# **Course Description**

Video production is designed to give you the building blocks you need to make and create better videos and learn how quality videos are produced. Videos are a great way to express yourself as an individual. The assignments will teach the importance of story telling, lighting, camera work, audio and filming production, editing and sharing videos with an understanding and appreciation for your own creativity!

#### Camera

You will not need your own video camera to succeed in this video production class, but it would be beneficial. Cameras can be checked out from time-to-time for video assignments. Students that bring their own cameras to class take the responsibility for taking care of their equipment as well as the school's equipment and if a camera is misplaced or stollen, it's not the schools responsibility, but the students and their parent. If a student barrows a camera from the school, it is their responsibility to take care of it and any battery chargers, or other equipment that is associated with the camera. CAMERAS MUST BE BACK TO THE SHCOOL WITHIN THREE (3) DAYS!

#### **Videos**

We will be filming a lot of footage in this class and some work will need to be filmed away from the school or after hours. Any videoing should never contain any nudity, profanity, illegal activities, or other inappropriate content that should not be viewed in school. None of the above items will be shown by students or the teacher in this class as well. Some locations are inappropriate to be filming, ask Mr. Crandall if questions.

**Extra Credit** No extra credit will be allowed unless a student is excused from school for a school event. Extra credit will be offered in the form of *more video work*, and only approved by Mr. Crandall.
